More Bonuses!

Thoroughbred Racing NT have already implemented an exciting selection of races for horses purchased from the Alice Springs and Darwin Magic Millions Tried Horse Sales, with two races in each centre held exclusively for NT Magic Millions Sales-bought runners.

Now a bonus scheme has been introduced to accompany these four races – horses with 51% or greater female ownership (**female-led ownership**) will be eligible for the following bonuses:

Female ownership bonus 1: \$3,000 to be paid to the winner if eligible, or \$2,000 to the first eligible horse past the post in 2nd to 5th;

Female ownership bonus 2: \$1,000 to be paid to the second eligible horse past the post in 2nd to 5th.

No TROBIS charge for eligible TRNT sale horses

Don't forget, Thoroughbred Racing NT will **automatically** TROBIS horses that are eligible from both TRNT Select Tried Horse Sales held in Alice Springs and Darwin. This will be a saving for purchasers of \$900 per horse.

The three eligible horses at the Alice Springs-hosted sale are lots 1, 3 and 5.

Alice Springs to host its first Cup Day Tried Horse Sales race!

All horses sold at any NT Magic Millions Select Tried Horse Sale (Alice Springs – 2023 and 2024; Darwin – 2013-2024) will be eligible to nominate for the \$50,000 Magic Millions Red Centre Classic to be held on Alice Springs Cup Day, 6 April, 2025.

A similar race was run in Darwin on Darwin Cup Day 2024, but now it is Alice's turn to get in on the sales race action.

The Magic Millions Red Centre Classic in Alice Springs on Cup Day this year will be the **Average Benchmark 1200m**, and the first nine horses home will receive stakemoney as follows:

1st \$30,000; 2nd \$7,000; 3rd \$4,000; 4th \$3,000; 5th \$2,000; 6th-9th \$1,000.

All other runners (if any) will receive an unplaced subsidy of \$700. Nomination \$165. Acceptance \$110. Apprentices cannot claim.



Thoroughbred Sales Auction Veterinary Protocol

1) History

- a. Race and trial results
 - a.i. Embargoes list (if any) epistaxis, heart irregularity, barrier incidents. a.ii. Prizemoney \$
- b. Surgery (date, place, type)
- c. Colic, tied-up, and vices weave, windsuck, box walk, transport issues.

2) Clinical Exam

- a. Comment normal or abnormal on heart, eyes, teeth, skin, feet
- b. Palpate distal limbs x 4, wither, back, pelvis and poll
- c. Photo measure stick for Height
- d. Photo horse standing on firm ground 1) near side and 2) front legs

3) Trot up

- a. Video
- b. Flexion tests individually of front legs

4) Endoscope of larynx

- a. Video
- a 45sec duration, right nostril, unsedated, includes nasal passage, pharyx
 a larynx undergoing 3 swallows with also a close up view of the arytenoid cartilages.
- c. Comment on laryngeal function (Lane or Havemyer) and any abnormalities

5) Radiographs (36 total)

- a. Front feet (X 2 views LM & O60°PR-PAOIO)
- Front fetlocks (X 6 views DPA, D45°L-PAMO, D45°M-PALO, FLEXED LM, FLEXED D125°OtSTAL-PAPROBUQUE, LM)
- c. Knees (X 6 views DPa, D55°L-PAMO, O75°M-PALO, FLEXED LM, FLEXED 060°PR, ODIS TAL OBLIQUE OF DISTAL CARPAL BONES)
- d. Hind fetlocks (X 4 views DPL, D45OL-PLMO, D45M-PLLO, LM)

6) Ultrasound

- a. Front limb flexor tendons and suspensory branches (transverse images focused on SOFT 1A, 18, 2A, 28, 3A, 38 and longitudinal images 1L, 2L, 3L. Suspensory branches medial and lateral 3a and 3b.
- b. Hind limb flexor tendons and proximal suspensory origin.
- c. Include measurements of forelimb tendons above 1A, 2A, 3A and medial and lateral branches 3b.

Nominated vet for Thoroughbred Racing NT – Dr Ben Mason BVsc, MANZCVSc (Radiology), BSc, MRCVS.

Conditions Of Sale

CONDUCT OF SALE

The highest bidder shall be the Purchaser on any Lot once any set reserved price has been attained.

The right is reserved to the Vendor, either personally or by an agent including the Auctioneers, to bid one or more times and to buy in the lot if the highest bidder.

If any dispute arises in the bidding, the lot shall be put up again immediately after the last undisputed bidding and resold or the dispute may be determined by the Auctioneer. The Auctioneer is the sole arbiter as to the existence or otherwise of any dispute.

The Auctioneer therefore may without giving any reason, refuse to accept any bid.

No person shall advance less at a bid than the sum nominated by the Auctioneer.

The Auctioneers reserve the right, without giving any reason therefore, to withdraw any lot or lots before or during the sale.

GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)

Bidding will be on a plus GST basis.

The vendor will pay GST on all supplies provided by the auctioneer and on all the supplies provided by the auctioneer as agent.

The auctioneer shall not in any circumstances have any liability or obligation to the vendor or any purchaser in relation to GST, and specifically shall not be under any obligation to pay to the vendor any amount in respect of GST on a sale unless and until the auctioneer has been paid the relevant GST by the purchaser.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PURCHASE

On the fall of the hammer the Purchaser of each lot shall give the Purchaser's Buyer Registration Number and his or her full name and address to the Auctioneers. The Purchaser shall sign and hand in to the Auctioneers an acknowledgement of the purchase. If the Purchaser fails to comply with this condition, each lot in respect of which such failure is made may, if the Auctioneer thinks fit, be put up again and resold. If upon such a resale a lower price is obtained for any lot than was obtained at the first Sale, the difference in price shall be a debt due by the Purchaser in default at the first bidding to the Vendor and recoverable from the Purchaser as such.

The Auctioneers and its clerks are authorized to sign the Sale book on behalf of both Vendors and Purchasers.

- The Purchasers, if more than one, shall be bound jointly and severally by these terms and conditions and shall
 carry out and perform the same jointly and severally.
- (2) Where a person who makes the highest bid is acting on behalf of a third party or principal, the person actually making the bid is and remains liable for payment in accordance with the conditions of Sale, whether or not the Auctioneers acknowledge the principal and whether or not the Auctioneers subsequently look to the principal for payment.

The person who signs an acknowledgement of purchase for any lot shall thereby be liable to pay the purchase price of the lot irrespective of whether or not that person was the bidder.

DISPUTES AND WAIVERS

The name, description and address of the Vendor as given by the Vendor are set out in the catalogue. In the case of any dispute the remedy of the Purchaser is against the Vendor only. In no case and under no circumstances is the remedy against the Auctioneers, who are agents of the Vendor.

The rights and remedies of the Auctioneers under these conditions shall not be affected by reason of the selling commission and charges of the Auctioneers having been deducted by the Auctioneers in any payment made by the Auctioneers to the Vendor and as between the Purchaser and the Vendor.

PAYMENT

Except if prior to the offering of the lot the Purchaser has made credit arrangements with the Auctioneers the purchase price for each lot shall be payable to the Auctioneers in full on the fall of the hammer. The Auctioneers will withhold delivery of a lot to a Purchaser until the purchase price and any additional charges are paid by the Purchaser.

CREDIT ARRANGEMENTS

An agreement between the Auctioneers and a Purchaser entered into prior to delivery of a lot shall not constitute a term or condition of the Sale of the lot between Vendor and Purchaser, but shall constitute a separate agreement between the Auctioneers and the Purchaser, independent of the agreement between the Vendor and the Purchaser.

PURCHASERS PLEASE NOTE

Purchasers requiring credit from the Auctioneers shall make application therefore prior to the Sale. Purchasers are cautioned that approval of credit for prior Sales does not establish credit for purchases at this Sale. To avoid misunderstanding, clients must re-establish credit before bidding.

Conditions Of Sale

PROPERTY IN LOTS

- (1) Delivery of any lot to a Purchaser or acceptance by the Auctioneers of a cheque tendered in payment for a lot, whether such tender is made prior to, at the time of, or subsequent to delivery of the lot shall not pass title in the lot to the Purchaser.
- (2) Title to each lot sold shall pass to the Purchaser only on payment to the Auctioneers of the purchase price and any interest payable thereon in cash or upon cleared funds being credited to the Auctioneers' account with its bank on the negotiation of any cheque accepted by the Auctioneers in respect of the purchase price.

DELIVERY AND INSURANCE

The Auctioneers reserve the right to require a Purchaser, to whom delivery of a lot is made prior to the payment of the purchase price in full, to effect insurance prior to delivery satisfactory to the Auctioneers in respect of damage, injury or death of the lot from any cause whatsoever and to ensure that the policy of insurance bears an endorsement noting the Auctioneer's and Vendor's interest in the lot, such insurance to be maintained until the purchase price is paid in full.

RISK AND EXPENSE

The Purchaser shall remove each lot purchased from the Auctioneers' premises on the day of the purchase. Any lot remaining on the Auctioneers' premises, (after the day of the purchase) may be moved by the Auctioneers at their convenience and stabled at alternative stables. All transport, stabling and feeding arrangements will be made at the discretion of the Auctioneers and the cost of risk of the Purchaser.

From the fall of the hammer the lot shall be at the risk of the Purchaser in all respects. Without limiting the generality thereof the Purchaser shall be responsible for all expenses of the care of the lot and all losses and expenses occasioned by the death or illness of or accident to the lot shall hold the Vendor and the Auctioneers indemnified against any such expenses and losses. Alice Springs Turf Club has the right to take any necessary action in the event of the Vendor or his representative being unavailable.

WINDSUCKERS AND WOBBLERS

If a lot is addicted to windsucking or proves to be a wobbler and that fact shall be disclosed by the Vendor to the Auctioneers, that fact shall be announced by the Auctioneers before offering the lot. If a lot proves to be a windsucker or wobbler within seven days of the Sale and the condition has not been disclosed at the time of offering, the Sale of the lot will be cancelled upon the Purchaser producing to the Auctioneers a certificate of a veterinary surgeon nominated by the Auctioneers obtained at the Purchaser's expense and upon return of the lot, in sound condition, all monies paid by the Purchaser shall be refunded by the Vendor without interest. Subject therefore to the Purchaser shall have no claim against the Vendor.

LOWER RESPIRATORY LARYNGOSCOPE EVALUATIONS

Not withstanding any other provision of these Conditions of Sale and notwithstanding any prior custom and usage of the trade, horses which are sold as racing prospects in this Sale may be subject to a post Sale upper respiratory laryngoscope evaluation (excluding the trachea) through a veterinary surgeon approved by the Auctioneers obtained at the Purchaser's expense within 48 hours of the Sale and prior to the horse leaving the Pioneer Park Racecourse Stables.

If the veterinarian is of the opinion that the horse has;

- (i) Laryngeal hemiplegia (complete immobility of the cartilage)
- (ii) rostral displacement of the palatopharyngeal arch
- (iii) epiglottic entrapment,
- (iv) subepiglottic cyst(s)

and this/these condition(s) have not been announced prior to the Sale, then the Purchaser may give notice in writing to the Auctioneers within 48 hours of the Sale of the veterinarian's certificate.

The Auctioneers shall then notify the Vendor as soon as practicable thereafter, who shall either accept rescission of the Sale or produce a veterinary certificate contrary to the Purchaser's veterinary certificate.

In such circumstances the Auctioneers shall appoint a third veterinarian whose opinion shall be final, binding and conclusive.

On the cancellation of the Sale, the lot shall be returned to the Auctioneer's premises or the Vendor's property, whichever is the nearer, at the Purchaser's expense and upon return of the lot, in sound condition, all monies paid by the Purchaser shall be refunded by the Vendor without interest. Subject thereto the Purchaser shall have no claim against the Vendor. The Vendor acknowledges that the Auctioneers shall not be responsible for or have any liability for damages, injuries or illness suffered by the horse during or as a result of such examination. The Veterinary Surgeon carrying out the examination acts as agent for the Purchaser not the Auctioneer.

Conditions Of Sale

CONDITIONS AND WARRANTIES

- (1) Subject only to the express provisions of these conditions, each lot is sold with all its faults. No error, omission or misdescription whether as to condition, soundness, fitness, quality pedigree, performance or engagement of any horse mentioned in the pedigree, the relationship of a lot or of a horse mentioned in the pedigree of a lot to any other horse, the number of foals which a mare has had, or as to which foal of a mare a lot is in order of foaling or otherwise or as to any progeny of any mare or horse mentioned in a pedigree is or otherwise in relation to any of the matters aforesaid shall annul or vitiate a Sale or entitle a Purchaser to any allowance, compensation, damages or rebate of any kind whatsoever.
- (2) Every condition representation and warranty implied by common law, equity, statute, custom or otherwise mentioned in the pedigree, the relationship of a horse or of a horse mentioned in the pedigree of a lot to any other horse, the number of foals which a mare has had, or as to which foal of a mare a lot is in order of foaling or otherwise or as to any progeny of any mare or horse mentioned in a pedigree is or that any condition or warranty implied by or required to be given by any statute of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia or the Northern Territory shall not be deemed to be excluded by this condition.
- (3) The Auctioneers give no representation or warranty that any lot is eligible for the Australian Stud Book.

DEFAULT BY PURCHASER

If the Purchaser of any lot shall fail to observe or perform these terms or conditions or any of them in respect of a lot all monies, if any, paid shall be absolutely forfeited to the Vendor who shall be at liberty without prejudice to any other right or remedy the Vendor may have be reason or on account of such default to cancel the Sale or at this Sale if the Auctioneers see fit, or at any future time, to resell such a lot by public auction or private contract without notice to the Purchaser. The deficiency (if any) between the amount of the purchase price at the present Sale plus the interest payable thereon and the cost and expenses of such resale and any expenses for keep, care of, and attention to and removal of the lot an the amount realized at such resale shall immediately be recoverable by the Vendor from the Purchaser as and for liquidated damages. Any increase in price on such resale shall belong to the Vendor.

TIME LIMITATIONS

No action proceeding or claim whether by way of defence or otherwise shall be brought or made against the Vendor or the Auctioneers in respect of or in any way arising out of or connected with a lot or the purchase of a lot by the Purchaser unless such action or proceeding is commenced or the claim or defence is raised within 28 days of the date of the Sale.

PUBLIC LIABILITY

Every person attending the Sale or entering the Auctioneers' premises does so at the persons own risk, and the Auctioneers shall not be in any way liable or responsible for any accident whatsoever to any person, or liable or responsible for any damage caused to any property in the Sale grounds.

APPLICABLE LAW

These Conditions of Sale are construed and shall take effect in accordance with the law of the Northern Territory, and any lot shall be deemed to have been sold in Alice Springs, Northern Territory.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PURCHASE

After making the final bid on a horse, purchasers are asked to complete and sign the Acknowledgement of Purchase Form. Please check that the Lot Number and price is correct before you sign.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

To avoid making costly errors, please pay close attention to all announcements made by the Auctioneers, especially concerning horses on which you intend to bid.

CARE OF HORSES

All horses remaining at the complex after the Sale will be fed and watered. However, any horse that remains at the complex more than 24 hours after midnight on 7 April 2025, the purchaser will be charged a levy of \$50 per day.

RETENTION OF HORSES AFTER SALE

No horse shall be released by Thoroughbred Racing NT to the purchaser until full payment has been made, or said purchaser has made prior suitable and agreed arrangements with Thoroughbred Racing NT.

CATALOGUING

All bloodstock in this Sale has been catalogued on the basis of their saleability. There is no warranty given or implied by the Auctioneers and Vendor as to their soundness or fitness for particular purpose of any horse offered for sale in the Auction.

INSURANCE

Purchasers are reminded that from the fall of hammer, horses are at their risk. Magic Millions Insurance Brokers is our preferred insurance provider. Should you wish to obtain a quote for your purchase, please email insurance@ magicmillions.com.au noting that any cover is subject to up-front payment of premium and relevant Health Documents being provided as requested by Magic Millions Insurance Brokers.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

PRE-SALE INSPECTION OF LOTS

WITHDRAWN OR PASSED IN LOTS

Should any horses catalogued by Thoroughbred Racing NT as Vendor be withdrawn from any sale due to sickness or injury, or passed in at sale, the conditions of eligibility listed will be applicable from the document date of any subsequent sale of withdrawn or passed in horses.

TROBIS

Buyers are reminded that the following lots in today's sale [lots 1, 3 and 5) will be automatically TROBISed by Thoroughbred Racing NT. There will be no charge to the purchasers for these horses to be entered into the TROBIS Scheme.

However, purchasers will need to advise Thoroughbred Racing NT of the registered owners in each TROBIS eligible horse to ensure that there is at least 25% NT ownership when the transfer of ownership is completed.

In the Northern Territory, TROBIS bonuses are applicable to all 3 and 4yos in eligible races.

RACE RECORD SUMMARY: 3yo gelding by Bon Aurum, sire of Bon's Pride and Brazen Bon, who are flying in the Top End. Wide draws have been an impediment in three of his five starts to date but he has made ground late and competed twice on the synthetic surface at Pakenham. Still learning his craft, but by a sire that has left gallopers proven on the sand and oil-based surfaces of the NT. TROBIS eligible.

VET EXAMINATION SUMMARY: 15.3hh-16hh (measured). Endoscopic examination performed, normal laryngeal function, Grade 1 scope. Conformation and walk good and he trotted up sound. Ultrasound examination was within normal limits. Radiographic changes are very mild and good for a racehorse of his age. Flexion tests of front fetlocks, knees, hind fetlocks and upper hind limbs all within normal limits. Full veterinary report, x-rays, video scope and scans available on request to Thoroughbred Racing NT.
